



Expectations for students from other colleges being taught in Jesus College

- All Oxford University students are strongly recommended to get vaccinated against Covid-19, if they are not already;
- Everyone is encouraged to take regular [LFD tests](https://www.ox.ac.uk/coronavirus/health/covid-testing/regular-testing). Tests can be collected from all colleges to their own members) and a number of other University locations (see <https://www.ox.ac.uk/coronavirus/health/covid-testing/regular-testing>)
- Students should not come into College if they have any Covid-19 symptoms;
- Everyone must wear a face mask in the Lodge area, teaching areas and any other public indoor space. Face masks in tutorials and classes will be at the discretion of tutors (although students may still choose to wear one even if not required);
- Students must immediately warn their tutor if they develop any Covid-19 symptoms within 48 hours of being taught in Jesus College; and they must update their tutor on the PCR result;
- Everyone must take hygiene precautions such as using sanitiser and washing hands
- Everyone is expected to be considerate of other people's space;
- On arrival, students should ring and bell and report to the Lodge staff which tutor they have come to see.
