To do before you arrive

- ☐ Complete student pre-registration.
 - You will be emailed via IT Service a University Single Sign on for the [Student Self Service website](#) once your returned University Contract has been processed.
 - Until you have been fully registered you won't be able to access online resources (e.g. meal booking) or enrolment certificate which you may need for a variety of purposes.
- ☐ RSVP for the Graduate Freshers' Dinner on Tuesday 14 October by **noon Friday 26 September** (<https://ams.jesus.ox.ac.uk/Forms/url/PGfreshersDinner2025freshers>).
- ☐ Familiarise yourself with the key documents available [here](#). Particularly, the College Student Handbook and the University Student Handbook as they will answer many of the questions you might have.
- ☐ Disclose any long-term health conditions or disabilities which may affect your studies by contacting our Student Support Officer, Katie Crabtree at student.support@jesus.ox.ac.uk.
- ☐ Register with [Eduroam](#) before you arrive.

To do when you arrive in Oxford

- ☐ Bring your passport and visit the Academic Office to complete your registration and collect your University card

- ☐ Complete the [Key Collection Letter](#) to hand to the Lodge on your arrival if you are staying in College accommodation
