	<ul> <li>Complete student pre-registration.</li> <li>You will be emailed via IT Service a University Single Sign on for the <u>Student Self Service</u> website once your returned University Contract has been processed.</li> <li>Until you have been fully registered you won't be able to access online resources (e.g. meal booking) or enrolment certificate which you may need for a variety of purposes.</li> </ul>
