Any area which is contaminated by bodily fluids will be cleaned thoroughly by the Housekeeping Team.
The first aider will consider what needs to be cleaned specifically looking at the following: - Surfaces touched by the individual - Surfaces touched by the First Aider
 If there are any body fluids, a spill kit will be used f no spill kit is available, cover with paper towels and ask advice from the emergency services when they arrive
